The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify. Classes are open to all members & non-members. Qualification cards will be provided in the ring.

EQUIFEST

This Show is affiliated to EQUIFEST, taking place at the Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the 6th – 9th August 2026. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify. Qualification cards will no longer be sent to the Show Secretary. Instead, **it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to download a qualification card before entering the show and getting this signed by either the Judge, Steward or Show Secretary at the time of qualification.** Qualification cards are available to download from the EQUIFEST website.

Classes 10 – 13; 15 - 19; 44 – 50; & 61

SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Committee reserves the right to cancel or alter the rotation of events.
2. Any protest (which must be made in writing by an exhibitor or representative stating the particulars and precise nature of the objection) must be deposited with the Secretary within one hour of the event and must be accompanied by a deposit of £25 which will be forfeited if in the opinion of the committee the objection proved frivolous.
3. Horses/ponies will be considered as being in the sole charge of their exhibitor/rider/owner. **Owners must ensure that they have full and current public liability insurance** to cover any damage, loss or injury caused by their animals/ riders/ vehicle/ equipment.
4. The Society will not be responsible for any damage, loss or injury to spectators or animals owing to accident or any other cause.
5. Personal safety: riders must wear appropriate **safety helmets which must meet current standards**. If in doubt, see BHS website. Helmets must be properly fitted, solid and unbroken. Helmets to be always worn when mounted. Appropriate riding footwear must also be worn. **Body Protectors advisable for all jumping classes**.
6. Riders birth certificates/pony height certificates may be required, and the Committee reserves the right to inspect these from winners in the classes where an age limit or height limit is specified.
7. **All riders must attain their 3rd birthday by 1st January in the current year**. All riders must be suitably mounted.
8. **Handlers of all lead rein ponies** must be at least 14 years of age.
9. Should any questions arise either upon the forgoing rules and regulations or upon any other matter connected with the show it shall be referred to the Committee whose decision shall be final. The Committee shall have the power to refuse any entry or cancel any entry which has been made.
10. All Dogs must be kept on leads and always be under control
11. **If your dog fouls, you must clean it up immediately**
12. **Equine welfare is of paramount importance. Horses and ponies should not be left tied up unattended to any horse box, trailer, tree or fence or by any other similar means.**

CUPS AND TROPHIES

Competitors are asked to note that Cups and Trophies are always owned by the Kings Heath Horse Show Society. Where cups and trophies are won by class winners, the cup/trophy is then loaned to the class winner until the day of the show in the following year.

If class winners or their parents choose to take a cup/trophy away from the show, they are agreeing to accept responsibility for its safe keeping and return. They must ensure that the cup/trophy is adequately insured/protected against theft/damage or loss. Please note that the replacement value of some cups is more than £400. All damage will be charged for at cost.

Also, if cups/trophies are removed from the showground, winning competitors (or their parents) are agreeing to return the cups/trophies (in the same condition that they were awarded) to the show secretary at least four weeks before the 2027 show. Failure to return cups by that date will be subject to a £50 fine plus the cost of replacing the cup.

Competitors are asked to note that where Cups and Trophies are shown in the schedule, the KHHS Committee will take all possible steps to ensure that these trophies are available for award on the day of the show. However, experience shows that cups and trophies are sometimes not returned on time by the previous year's winner. In this case it may not be possible to present trophies as shown in the schedule.

All competitors winning cups/trophies (or their parents if under 18) will be required to sign a receipt accepting their obligations as detailed above. Cups/trophies will only be handed to class winners and/or their parents.

Class 2 will have no fillers - poles only. Single phase. This is aimed at pure NOVICES and NERVOUS riders. Please do not enter this class if the pony/horse and rider combination has been placed first three times in the current or previous years. Competitors for this class will only be permitted to enter classes 3.

Class 3 – Novice jumping 40cm

This class will have no fillers and will be poles only. Single phase. This is aimed at NOVICES and NERVOUS riders. Do not enter this class if the pony/horse and rider combination has been placed first three times in the current or previous years. Competitors for this class will not be permitted to enter class 6 or 7.

Class 4 – 50cm jumping

Single phase.

Class 5 – 60cm jumping

LEO CRAVEN MEMORIAL CUP awarded to the winner of this class. These cups can be retained by class winners' courtesy of the Craven family. Single phase.

Driving classes to commence at 2pm

Class 8 – Pleasure Driving

Open to horses, ponies, donkeys and mules, 4 years old and over. A single, pair or tandem driven to a vehicle capable of seating 2 or more persons. Traditional or non-traditional vehicles are permitted for the purpose of this class, they will be judged on equal merit. Pneumatic tyres specifically designed for carriages (not car tyres) are allowed. Lamps need not be carried. To be judged on cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness and vehicle suitability. To be judged 15% vehicle suitability, fit and cleanliness, 15% harness suitability, fit and cleanliness, 70% driver and groom, horse or pony, way of going and suitability as a family pleasure animal. Competitors may, for example be required to drive and halt between two pairs of cones and/or other specific movements to execute their show. Peter Checkley Perpetual Trophy and Rawlings Brothers Cup will be awarded to the winner.

Class 9 – In-Hand Driving Type

Open to driving type horses, ponies and donkeys 4 years old or over. Entries to be judged on suitability and turnout.

Class 11 – Youngstock Mountain & Moorland in-hand Large Breeds *(yearlings, two- and three-year-olds) open to colts, fillies and geldings. Pure bred ponies only. Dales, Fells, Highlands, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh C & D*

Class 12 – Mountain & Moorland in-hand Small Breeds *(4 years and over) open to colts, fillies and geldings. Pure bred ponies only. Shetlands, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B*

Class 13 – Mountain & Moorland in-hand Large Breeds *(4 years or over) open to colts, fillies, geldings. Pure bred ponies only. Dales, Fells, Highlands, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh C & D*

Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year. Spurs must not be worn

Led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only

Class 19 – TSR FIRST RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR & EQUIFEST QUALIFIER Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their Pure-Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A or B. Mares or geldings 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthdays but not attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Class 46 – TSR RIDDEN HUNTER AMATEUR OF THE YEAR & EQUIFEST Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exceeding 148cms. Riders must have attained their 15th birthday by the day of the Show. Spurs may be worn by adult riders

Class – 47 – EQUIFEST IN-HAND VETERAN Open to horses and ponies of any breed, type and height, 15 years and over. Riders of any age, suitably mounted – animals will not be galloped. Class 60 – Best Riding Club Horse to be judged on suitability and turnout. Horses exceeding 148cm. Jump optional.

Class 61 – Open Ridden Sport Horse for horses 4yrs and over. Exceeding 14.2hh

Class 62 – EQUIFEST OPEN RE-TRAINED RACEHORSE Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Horses must have been raced in the GB to be eligible to compete

Class 63 – Pure Bred, Anglo or part bred Arab registered or unregistered, mare or gelding, 4 yrs and over and height – highest placed junior (under 21) competitor will receive a rosette from the Arab Horse Society along with an AHS Membership subscription.

Class 64 – Youngstock – (*yearlings, two- and three-year-olds*) colt, filly or gelding any height

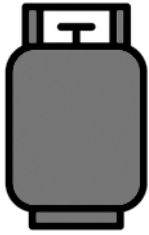

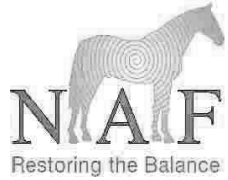

Our showground is situated on Tithe Barn Lane, just off Broad Lane (B4101), Earlswood, Solihull, West Midlands, B94 5DH

Please note: there is a Tythe Barn Lane nearby at Whitlock End, Cheswick Green, this is several miles away from our showground.

You can obtain a good map of the area by accessing <http://maps.google.com/> and entering the postcode B94 5DN

Directions from M42: Leave M42 at J3 exit. Turn south onto the A435 Alcester Road. After about a mile, Turn left onto Broad Lane (B4101), go through Aspley Heath and Wood End. Go past the left hand turn to Earlswood Common (B4102). Take the next main left hand turn onto Tithe Barn Lane. Cross over the motorway and the showground is on the left hand side.

Directions from Hockley Heath: Take the turning onto Spring Lane at the south end of Hockley Heath. This is signposted the B4101. Stay on the B4101. It becomes Pound House Lane and then Broad Lane. After about 3 miles from Hockley Heath turn right onto Tithe Barn Lane. Cross over the motorway and the showground is on the left hand side.

Look out locally for signs to the **KHHS showground.**

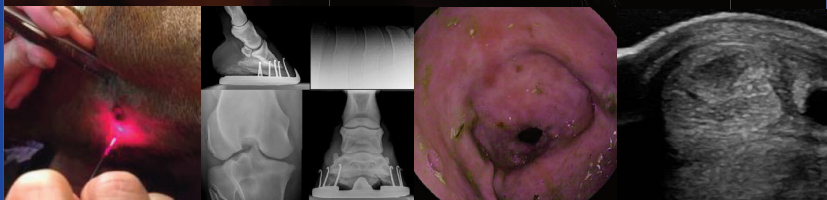
